



Manhattanville in West Harlem Campus Plan

Columbia's long-term plan for the old Manhattanville manufacturing area will revitalize the four former industrial blocks from 125th/129th to 133rd Street between Broadway and 12th Avenue, and three small blocks along the east side of Broadway from 131st to 134th Street, into an environmentally sustainable and publicly accessible center for academic and civic life woven into the fabric of the West Harlem community.

Construction Activities for the Weeks of September 14, 2026 and September 21, 2026

Site at 125th Street and 12th Avenue

- Demolition of slurry-wall guide walls along 125th Street. Work may cause some noise and vibrations.
- Installation of underground stormwater concrete structures and piping will commence
- Surveying for different soil types
- Trenching for soil remediation and separating trench construction items
- Trucking soil and concrete debris off-site to disposal facilities
- Integrated pest control sitewide

- Work hours are 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday.
- Expect noise, vibrations, delivery of materials, and other impacts typically associated with construction projects.
