Michels Health Careers Scholarship Program in 2013, (the "Program") was created to increase the number of local residents entering the medical field and to provide job opportunities and training at Columbia-Presbyterian Medical Center.

As stated in the Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions dated December 14, 2011, Columbia University ("Columbia") has agreed to commit \$1 million to expand the Stanley E. Annual payments began in 2011 and will continue through 2020, provided that the program continues to operate in substantially the same manner as it currently does. 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
