Mind Brain Behavior Public Outreach Center. CU shall locate within Development Site 2 (the proposed Jerome L. Greene Science Center) a Screening and Education Center for community outreach. The purpose of the Center shall be to provide stroke awareness lectures and free blood pressure and cholesterol screenings. The Center shall commence operation upon issuance of the temporary certificate of occupancy for the Jerome L. Greene Science Center and operate for a 25-year period from commencement of full operation.

*The center opened to the public in September 2017. Therefore, this obligation will be in effect until 2042, 25 years from the commencement of the center's full operation.

Alternatives Based on Innovation

Columbia University's Wellness Center opened in the Jerome L. Greene Science Center in 2017 and has since provided health education, community resources and free health screenings to the West Harlem community, as well as trained members of the Harlem community to become advocates to prevent stroke and mental health through the Institute for Training Outreach and Community Health (InTOuCH) and Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) programs. The success of this training led to the expansion of the Center's focus to building capacity in the community, by training individuals from faith and community-based organizations (CBO) to be certified community health workers.

In 2023, upgrades were made to the Wellness Center model to focus on Community Health Worker (CHW) training and the center was renamed to "Columbia Center for Community Health". Under the center's supervision, these CHWs continue to provide stroke awareness lectures, free blood pressure, and cholesterol screenings, but with the evidence driven framework of meeting people where they are. Screenings are largely performed off-site, at local faith and community-based organizations or at community-focused health events. The Center continues to operate in the Jerome L. Greene Science Center as a screening and education center focused on stroke awareness and free blood pressure and cholesterol screenings.

**Located in Columbia University's new
Jerome L. Greene Science Center in West Harlem**

The Wellness Center provides free blood pressure readings, cholesterol screening and A1C glucose testing to the community. Visitors will receive a record of their results, as well as information on ways they can improve their health.

On request, Wellness Center staff will provide information about free and low-cost health care available throughout Harlem and upper Manhattan. The Wellness Center will also provide onsite assistance with health insurance enrollment.

In addition to providing free blood pressure and cholesterol screening, the Wellness Center is home to two programs dedicated to empowering the community through health education.

The Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) program is dedicated to improving access to quality mental health in Harlem. The program teaches participants the warning signs of mental health problems, helps build an understanding of the importance of early intervention and seeking support. Information about support groups, tools for mental health, and local resources will be provided.

The Institute for Training Outreach and Community Health (InTOuCH) is a free community-based program designed to raise awareness about stroke and heart attack prevention. Through its rigorous training program, InTOuCH participants commit to serving the community as volunteer health workers and as counselors at Columbia's Wellness Center and local screening events.

State Submission Annual Reporting Period: **October 2023 - September 2024**

The Columbia Center for Community Health operates out of the Jerome L. Greene Science Center and provides health education, community resources and free health screenings to the West Harlem community, and trains members of the Harlem community to become advocates to prevent stroke and mental health through the Institute for Training Outreach and Community Health (InTOUCH) and Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) programs.

The Center focuses on Community Health Worker (CHW) training. Under the center’s supervision, these CHWs provide stroke awareness lectures, free blood pressure, and cholesterol screenings. Screenings are often performed off-site at local faith and community-based organizations or at community-focused health events (see attached report for more information). The Center continues to operate in the Jerome L. Greene Science Center as a screening and education center focused on stroke awareness and free blood pressure and cholesterol screenings.

Stroke Awareness

The Columbia Center for Community Health houses the Community Health Worker Stroke Prevention program, which empowers communities to combat stroke. The program includes 6-week trainings, held throughout the year that provide local residents with the tools they need to become community health workers. Volunteers learn about various cardiovascular health topics, including motivational interviewing, with a special emphasis on stroke and related risk factors. Alumni of the program serve as health advocates in their communities and at faith-based organizations, with the overall goal of improving stroke outcomes and lowering the prevalence of stroke and related risk factors. The curriculum was developed with the assistance of community focus groups and in consultation with experts in health education.

The program, modeled on the Center for Disease Control and Prevention’s CHW training curriculum, with the addition of culturally tailored multimedia components, is led by Olajide Williams, MD, chief of staff of neurology and associate professor of neurology at Columbia University Medical Center, founder of Hip Hop Public Health, and codirector of the Center for Stroke Disparities Solutions in New York.

COLUMBIA CENTER FOR COMMUNITY HEALTH

The Columbia Center for Community Health (CCCH), situated within Columbia's Zuckerman Institute on the Manhattanville campus, is entering an exciting new phase. Previously known as the Columbia Wellness Center, the CCCH underwent a significant transformation in 2023, adopting a new name that reflects its broadened mission. This change underscores the CCCH's commitment to certifying and training community health workers (CHWs) and enhancing the health of the Uptown community. Through community capacity building and health promotion, the CCCH aims to support and empower local residents.

The CCCH is led by co-directors Dr. Olajide Williams, a distinguished neurologist, and Dr. Robert Fullilove, a public health expert, both recognized for their innovative approaches to improving public health in Harlem and Washington Heights. Under their guidance, the training and certification of CHWs has become a central focus of the CCCH, emphasizing the vital role these frontline workers play in healthcare delivery.

Training Hub for Community Health Workers

Community Health Workers are essential public health advocates who typically reside in the communities they serve, possessing a unique ability to disseminate vital information effectively, as noted by the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute. The Institute for Training Outreach and Community Health (InTOuCH), currently directed by Dr. Janhavi Mallaiah alongside Mariama Kora, Ulda Louis-Pierre, and Mary Redd, serves as the CCCH's primary training initiative. It offers free training and certification for individuals interested in becoming CHWs.

The comprehensive eight-week training program comprises six weeks of coursework followed by two weeks of hands-on practicum. To date, InTOuCH has successfully trained and certified 252 CHWs, who now serve as trusted advocates within their communities.

New Focus and Strengthening Local Connections

With its rebranding, the CCCH has embraced a new focus on five key areas: training, outreach, research, screening, and workforce development. By prioritizing these areas, the CCCH aims to enhance its InTOuCH program, expand the provision of community health screenings, and foster opportunities for research initiatives that are relevant to local needs.

This endeavor includes strengthening partnerships with local faith-based and community organizations and enhancing outreach to marginalized populations, including formerly

incarcerated individuals. Currently, the CCCH collaborates with 94 houses of faith throughout Uptown and the five boroughs of New York City.



In 2022, InTOuCH partnered with Vocational Instruction Project (VIP) Community Services to deliver free CHW training to their staff and clients. The CCCH will continue its collaboration with VIP Community Services, a Federally Qualified Health Center and Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic that offers a range of services, including primary care, housing, and medication-assisted treatment.

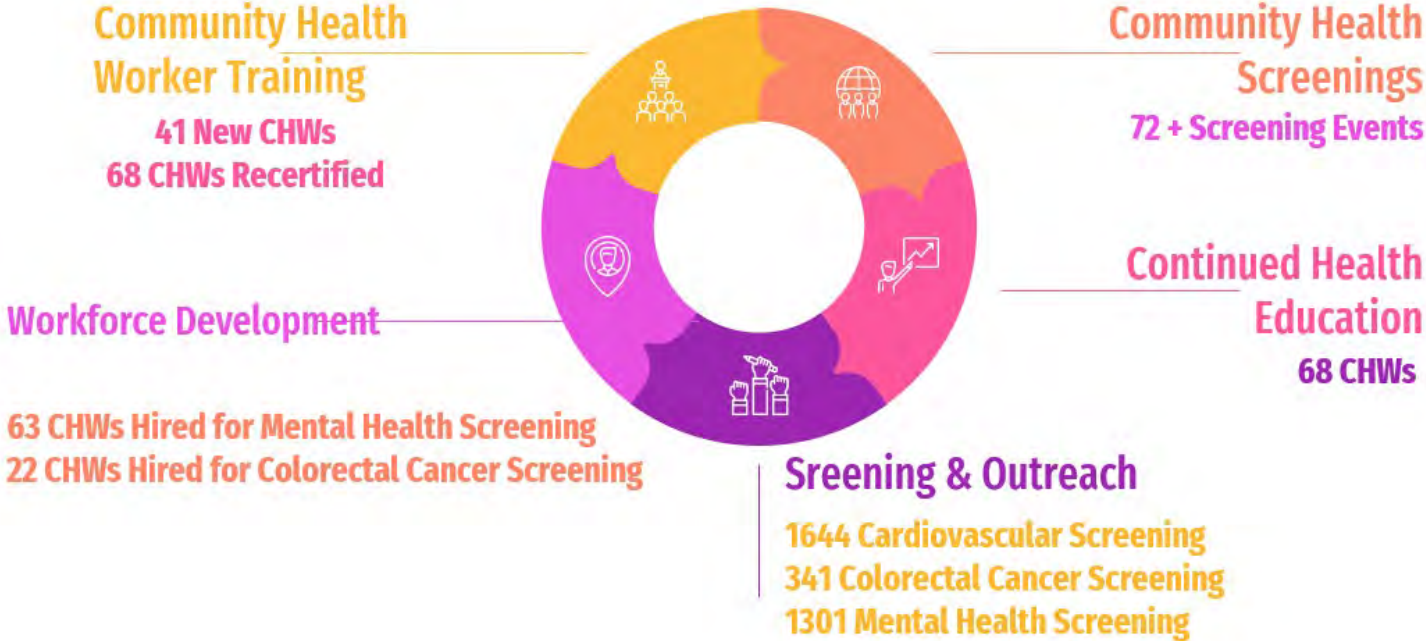
Reflecting on this new chapter..

HIGHLIGHTS FROM 2023-2024

- **Community Health Workers:** 252 CHWs trained and certified from 2016 - 2024
- **Cohort Training (Cohorts 16 & 17):** 41 new Community Health Workers (CHWs) trained and certified.
- **Alumni Refresher Training & Recertification:** 68 CHWs successfully completed refresher training and were recertified.
- **Community Health Screenings:** Conducted 106 community health screenings.
- **Mental Health Screenings:** Screened 1,301 community members
- **Colorectal Cancer Screening:** Screened 341 community members
- **CONNECT Conference 2023:** Participated in the conference for community health stakeholders including community leaders, community health workers, researchers, clinicians, public health practitioners, policymakers, and students.
- **Community & Academic Partnerships:** Established 90 new partnerships with community organizations and academic institutions.
- **Faith-Based Partnerships:** Partnered with 94 houses of faith to expand outreach and health services.
- **First Annual Community Health Fair:** Hosted by the Columbia Center for Community Health, the fair attracted over 500 attendees, offering health education, screenings, and family-friendly activities.
- **Formation of New Community Advisory Board:** Welcomed five new leaders from West Harlem Development, 100 Black Men, 100 Black Women, NYS Office of Mental Health, and the Board of Education to guide community initiatives.

WHERE SHOULD I BE?

BLOOD PRESSURE

- Normal: Less than 120/80
- Prehypertension: 120/80 to 139/89
- Hypertension: 140/90 and higher

BLOOD GLUCOSE

- Normal: under 99 mg/dl and below
- Prediabetes: 100-125 mg/dl to 139/89
- Diabetes: 126 mg/dl and above
- Blood sugar should be less than 100 after an 8 hour fast and less than 140 during the rest of the day

CHOLESTEROL

Total Cholesterol: Desirable less than 200 mg/dl

- Borderline high: 200-239 mg/dl
- High: 240 mg/dl and above

HDL CHOLESTEROL

An HDL cholesterol of less than 40 mg/dl is a major risk factor for heart disease

LDL CHOLESTEROL

- Optimal: Less than 100 mg/dl
- Near Optimal: 100-129 mg/dl
- Borderline High: 130-159 mg/dl
- High 160-189 mg/dl
- Very High: 190 mg/dl and above

BMI (Body Mass Index) is a measure of body fat using height and weight

- Normal Weight: BMI = 18.5 - 24.9
- Overweight: BMI = 25 - 29.9
- Obese: BMI = 30 or greater

Waist Circumference more than 40 inches in a man and more than 35 inches in a woman indicates a high risk of type 2 diabetes, high blood pressure high cholesterol and heart disease.

BODY FAT PERCENTAGE is the percentage of fat your body contains.

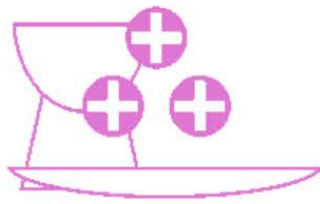

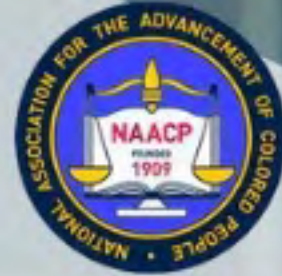
