**Obligation**

*Mind Brain Behavior Public Outreach Center.* CU shall locate within Development Site 2 (the proposed Jerome L. Greene Science Center) a Screening and Education Center for community outreach. The purpose of the Center shall be to provide stroke awareness lectures and free blood pressure and cholesterol screenings. The Center shall commence operation upon issuance of the temporary certificate of occupancy for the Jerome L. Greene Science Center and operate for a 25-year period from commencement of full operation.

\*The center opened to the public in September 2017. Therefore, this obligation will be in effect until 2042, 25 years from the commencement of the center's full operation.

**Innovation; Changed Conditions**

Columbia University's Wellness Center opened in the Jerome L. Greene Science Center in 2017 and has since provided health education, community resources and free health screenings to the West Harlem community, as well as trained members of the Harlem community to become advocates to prevent stroke and mental health through the Institute for Training Outreach and Community Health (InTOuCH) and Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) programs. The success of this training led to the expansion of the Center's focus to building capacity in the community, by training individuals from faith and community-based organizations (CBO) to be certified community health workers.

In 2023, upgrades were made to the Wellness Center model to focus on Community Health Worker (CHW) training and the center was renamed to "Columbia Center for Community Health". Under the center's supervision, these CHWs continue to provide stroke awareness lectures, free blood pressure, and cholesterol screenings, but with the evidence driven framework of meeting people where they are. Screenings are largely performed off-site, at local faith and community-based organizations or at community-focused health events. The Center continues to operate in the Jerome L. Greene Science Center as a screening and education center focused on stroke awareness and free blood pressure and cholesterol screenings.

The Columbia Center for Community Health (CCCH) operates out of the Jerome L. Greene Science Center and provides health education, community resources and free health screenings to the West Harlem community, and trains members of the Harlem community to become advocates to prevent stroke and mental health through the Institute for Training Outreach and Community Health (InTOuCH) and Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) programs.

The CCCH is committed to certifying and training community health workers (CHWs) and positively impacting the health of the Uptown community. Through community capacity building and health promotion, the CCCH is dedicated to supporting and empowering the local community.

Leading the CCCH are co-directors Dr. Olajide Williams, a distinguished neurologist, and Dr. Robert Fullilove, a public health expert, both renowned for their pioneering approaches to improving public health in Harlem and Washington Heights. Under their leadership, the training and certification of CHWs has become central to the CCCH’s mission, reflecting the critical role these frontline workers play in healthcare. Under the center’s supervision, these CHWs provide stroke awareness lectures, free blood pressure, and cholesterol screenings. Screenings are often performed off-site at local faith and community-based organizations or at community-focused health events (see attached report for more information). The Center continues to operate in the Jerome L. Greene Science Center as a screening and education center focused on stroke awareness and free blood pressure and cholesterol screenings.

**Stroke Awareness**

The Columbia Center for Community Health houses the Community Health Worker Stroke Prevention program, which empowers communities to combat stroke. The program includes 6-week trainings, held throughout the year that provide local residents with the tools they need to become community health workers. Volunteers learn about various

cardiovascular health topics, including motivational interviewing, with a special emphasis on stroke and related risk factors. Alumni of the program serve as health advocates in their communities and at faith-based organizations, with the overall goal of improving stroke outcomes and lowering the prevalence of stroke and related risk factors. The curriculum was developed with the assistance of community focus groups and in consultation with experts in health education.

The program, modeled on the Center for Disease Control and Prevention’s CHW training curriculum, with the addition of culturally tailored multimedia components, is led by Olajide Williams, MD, chief of staff of neurology and associate professor of neurology at Columbia University Medical Center, founder of Hip Hop Public Health, and codirector of the Center for Stroke Disparities Solutions in New York.

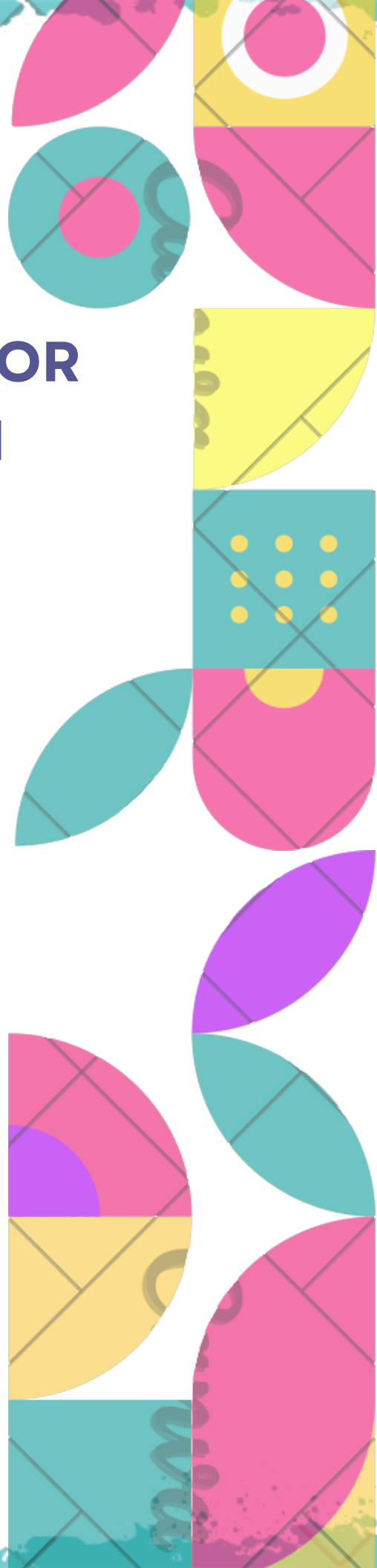

## History & Mission

The Columbia Center for Community Health (CCCH), located within Columbia University's Zuckerman Institute, continues to serve as a hub for training, outreach, screening, and research to strengthen the frontline public health workforce.



- **Origins:** Formerly the Columbia Wellness Center, CCCH was re-established in 2023 to reflect an expanded mission of improving health equity in Harlem, Washington Heights, and beyond.
- **Leadership:** Co-directed by Dr. Olajide Williams and Dr. Robert Fullilove, with day-to-day leadership of the Institute for Training Outreach and Community Health (InTOuCH) provided by Dr. Janhavi Mallaiah, Samantha Drummond, Anne-Elie Etienne, Mary Redd, Neal Sutton, Glenn McMillan.
- **Community Health Worker (CHW) Training:** Since inception, CCCH has trained and certified over 293 CHWs, equipping them with skills in health promotion, chronic disease prevention, and health system navigation.
- **Collaborations:** CCCH works closely with faith-based organizations, academic partners, city agencies, and community leaders to deliver accessible, community-centered health interventions.

# HIGHLIGHTS FROM 2024 – 2025

## **Community Health Worker Training**

- Trained 41 new CHWs (Cohorts 18 & 19).
- First cohort of NYC Department of Health staff trained (Cohort 19).
- Total to date: 293 CHWs trained and certified since program inception.

## **Alumni Development & Workforce Expansion**

- 24 alumni CHWs trained as health insurance navigation assistants.
- 17 community members successfully enrolled in health insurance with CHW support.
- 33 alumni recertified through refresher training.
- 170 alumni participated in continued health education workshops offered in collaboration with the NYC Department of Health's Center for Health Equity and Community Wellness (CHECW).

## **Community Screenings & Outreach**

- Participated in 49 health fairs across NYC.
- Screened 717 community members for blood pressure and provided health counseling.
- 236 Blood Pressure and Cholesterol Screenings conducted at the Center
- Alumni and community walk-ins were welcomed for Knowledge, Attitudes, and Practices (KAP) surveys, biometric data collection, and health screenings, including blood pressure, cholesterol, and counseling.
- Engaged residents through outreach at faith-based institutions, community centers, and public events.

## **Research**

- 123 community members enrolled in the Community Health Workers United to Reduce Colorectal Cancer and Cardiovascular Disease among people at Higher Risk (C.H.U.R.CH) trial.

## LOOKING FORWARD

- **Expansion of Alumni Programming:** More tailored trainings in health equity, digital health, and chronic disease management.
- **Enhanced Community Screenings:** Broader coverage of cardiovascular and mental health screenings.
- **Workforce Integration:** Strengthened pathways for CHWs into health systems, social services, and public health agencies.
- **Sustainability:** Building a revised digital learning platform to complement the in-person CHW training experience.
- **Atrial Fibrillation Awareness Initiative:** Through the Pulse Check Project, CCCH will partner with Hip Hop Public Health and community organizations to train CHWs on atrial fibrillation (AFib) awareness, screening, and education, equipping them with toolkits to improve early detection and prevention.
- **National Collaboration on Social Determinants of Health:** Partnering with the Pear Suite network of CHWs nationwide, CCCH is evaluating the Protocol for Responding to and Assessing Patients' Assets, Risks, and Experiences (PRAPARE) tool. Insights from this collaboration will inform the development of a new CHW toolkit on chronic disease assessment, integrating components of social determinants of health (SDOH).
- **CHW Champions in Action:** Working with our CHW champions to share community resource guides with residents during health fairs and walk-in screenings, ensuring better linkage to local services and supports.
